Dear Instructor,

It is with the greatest pleasure that, on behalf of the Glanmire School of Taekwon-Do, we would like to cordially invite both you and your students to the Jee-Goo and Brooklodge Friendly Tournament to be held in Little Island Sports Complex, Cork on Saturday, 16th of April, 2016.

I sincerely hope that you and your students will join us in Cork for this event.

The competition will be run under A.E.T.F. rules, with divisions for male and female, senior and junior for patterns and sparring at colour belt level only. In addition, a special technique section (overhead kick) will be held for those aged 12 and under. With the provision of sufficient umpires, four rings will be run to ensure that the competition runs as efficiently as possible. Each club **must** provide an umpire, however, we encourage as many black belts as possible to practice and improve their umpiring skills by taking part on the day.

Please note it is compulsory for all competitors to wear head gear. Shin-guards and gum-shields are compulsory for all competitors while groin guards are mandatory for male competitors. Each club with attending students must put forward an umpire.

White – Yellow Tags	6-8 / 9-10 / 11-12 / 13-14 /15-17 / 18+
Yellow – Green Belt	as above
Blue Tag – Red Tag	as above
Red Belt to Black Tag	as above

Categories may be amalgamated or sub divided depending on numbers

(2) Categories for Sparring:

All sections will be divided into male and female and then into lightweight and heavyweight where appropriate.

Section	Grade
10 and under:	Yellow – Green Tag
	Green Belt – Red Tag
	Red Tip – Black Tip
11-12:	As Above
13-14:	As Above
15-17:	As Above
18 + :	As Above

Categories may be amalgamated or sub divided depending on numbers

(3) Special Technique

Overhead kick Categories will be subdivided based on numbers. Please note this category is only for students 12 years and under
